Introduction

Archives provide current and future generations with evidence of the foundation on which their society is built. While paper-based archives have dominated for more than four centuries due to print technology's historical advantage, the development of photography, sound and video recordings in the 19th and 20th centuries have added a new dimension to the form that archives now take. The coming of the Digital Age has also accelerated the use of conventional and new digital media. Rapidly changing technologies are fuelling growth and change in the audiovisual industry, but also opportunities. Audiovisual sources allow us a window to hear and view the world from one place, provide a slice of our history and culture, is a good primary source for research alongside written sources, and can be an effective educational tool for deeper understanding of a subject. Moreover, Trinidad and Tobago has a strong oral culture with a myriad of intangible heritage forms – music, dance, traditional medicine and knowledge, language, oral history, all of which can only be adequately preserved through audiovisual media.

The National Archives of Trinidad and Tobago acknowledges that audiovisual records, such as films, radio and television programmes, audio and video recordings contain the primary records of the 20th and 21st century and should be an integral part of its national archival collection. By transcending language and cultural boundaries, audiovisual records have become a permanent complement to the traditional paper record.

The National Archives works closely with Government media to preserve its audiovisual analogue collections and acquires other collections which can add value to the national collection. Through the implementation of the *Digitization of Government Media Assets Project*, numerous film and analogue video and audio tapes from the 1960s to 1990s have been preserved for future generations. They are being made accessible not only for researchers but also for video production houses. The collections listed in this preliminary guide is an initial list of what is available for viewing in the National Archives' Public Search Room for research and education purposes. It includes audio and video collections from the:

Please note that numerous audio and video recordings are available on the work of the Government over time, as well as archival footage related to culture and national development.

Interested persons are required to walk with their own personal headphones for health and safety reasons and also, so as not to disrupt the work of other researchers.

Government Broadcasting Unit (GBU)

The Government Broadcasting Unit was the official Government arm responsible for producing and disseminating Government information via radio from the 1950s. Its history is closely linked to the history of radio. Following the introduction of Rediffision (Trinidad) Ltd, a wire distribution service from the 1940s, two AM radio stations later emerged – Radio Trinidad (1947) and Radio Guardian (1958). One of the provisions for the licencing of radio stations was that each station provided the Government with seventy-five (75) minutes of air time daily. Regular production of radio programmes was ramped up through the hiring of a Broadcasting Officer in 1950. Facilities later expanded through an arrangement with the British Council. Kenneth Ablack was brought in as Broadcasting Adviser from BBC during the West Indies Federation.

This collection spans the period of the 1960s to 1990s and includes interviews, news coverage of various national and local events including Carnival, other festivals and lectures, as well as educational and cultural programmes, including:

- Eric Williams – speeches and interviews
- Opening of Parliament 1962
- Signing of Treaty to establish CARICOM, Chaguaramas 1973

Some of these recordings are unique as they are not available in any other format such as video. Interviews with national icons form an integral part of our national oral history.

Government Film Unit /British Film Institute

The Government Film Unit evolved from the Colonial Film Unit which was established in the 1940s. The Colonial Film Unit was responsible for distributing British newsreels to cinemas until it began producing local film from 1957 following training in film production in Jamaica. In this period the film had to be processed overseas, in the United Kingdom. Later on, Trinidad and Tobago Television (TTT) developed the facility to process and project black and white film. The Government Film Unit which operated from St. James, became the Television Unit in 1986, when video was introduced.

This collection comprises digitized film documentaries, news magazine features, advertisements from the 1950s-1970s, which were held by the British Film Institute, United Kingdom.

Government Information Division

The Information Division, Office of the Prime Minister, had its genesis in the Colonial Information Office which was set up in the 1940s. After Independence, the Colonial Information Office became the Public Relations Unit, under the Office of the Prime Minister. It comprised the following functional units: Television, Radio, Press/Public Relations, Photography, Library, Research, and Administration.

This collection comprises productions done by the Government Information Division from 1970s to 1990s. It includes documentaries, coverage of Government's activities and national development issues covering the administrations under Prime Ministers Dr. Eric Williams, George Chambers, Patrick Manning, and A.N.R. Robinson, budget presentations, interviews, etc.

Television Series

GAYELLE

A half hour weekly cultural magazine series which ran from 1985 to 1992. Over 300 episodes of cultural programmes on Carnival, festivals, and various aspects of Trinidad and Tobago's culture. Gayelle has been acclaimed at many international festivals and showings and it has served as a model for the creation of similar productions in the Caribbean, Central America.

CARIBBEAN EYE

Thirteen half hour documentaries on Caribbean Culture produced in 1992 and presented by veteran Caribbean broadcaster, Ken Corsbie. Caribbean Eye represents a pioneering effort in regional television. It is the first documentary series about the Caribbean made by the Caribbean.

EYE TO EYE – Ways of Seeing

A 26 part one-hour television series produced in 2010. Produced with Gayelle, The Channel, *Eye to Eye* is a series of one on one conversations with people who work out of a strong sense of being Caribbean and what that means. The host is producer, Christopher Laird and among the guests are Pat Bishop, Rawle Gibbons, Frances-Anne Solomon, Raviji, Tony Hall, Sunity Maharaj, Christopher Cozier, Paul Keens-Douglas, Mungal Patasar, Brother Resistance (Lutalo Masimba), Burton Sankerali, Lester Efebo Wilkinson, Wendell Manwarren, Georgia Poplewell, Dennis Hall.
